RESOLUTION IN APPRECIATION OF MICHIGAN 911 TELECOMMUNICATORS

WHEREAS, the week of April 9-15, 2023, has been designated NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS WEEK.

WHEREAS, the number 911 is universally recognized as being dedicated to report emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the telecommunicator response to calls for help gives the citizens of Michigan a quick response to emergency calls for police, fire, or emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, the safety of police officers, firefighters, and paramedics is dependent upon the actions of the telecommunicator, and the quality and accuracy of the information obtained from citizens who contact 911;
